

**Learning, Earning, and Investing Workshop  
For Teachers in Grades 6-12  
Saturday, September 25, 2010  
9:00 AM – 2:00 PM**



Is your mind spinning at the thought of teaching your students about the state of the economy and the stock market?? Let us help! The Center for Economic Education at Eastern Kentucky University and the Kentucky Council on Economic Education are offering a workshop that will introduce you to resources you can use to teach your students about investing and the stock market and provide grade-appropriate resources for you to use in your classroom. The workshop will be held in the Perkins Building on EKU's south campus in Richmond on **Saturday, September 25**. Questions that will be addressed include the following:

- How can I teach my students about investing and about the stock market using the “Learning, Earning, and Investing” curriculum?
- How can I use the Stock Market Game in my class even if I don't know anything about the stock market?

This workshop is geared for teachers in grades 6-12, and all teachers who attend the entire workshop will do the following:

- Learn economics and practical living content related to consumer decisions
- Take home the “Learning, Earning, and Investing” curriculum which is valued at \$25 and receive a complimentary lunch at the workshop
- Receive either 3 FREE student teams for the Fall or Spring, 2010-11 Stock Market Game OR play FREE as a teacher during the semester
- Receive PD certificates in the mail after the workshop for 5 hours of PD
- Have the opportunity to earn an additional hour of PD by participating in online follow-up activities

There is a **\$10 registration fee** to attend this workshop, and this must be paid in advance.
