

Saving Spree Game

Supply List

- 1. Number Cards
- 2. Piggy Bank
- 3. Piggy Bank Recording Sheet
- 4. 30 bingo chips for each player
- 5. 30 bingo chips for the piggy bank
- 6. Spinner sheet
- 7. 1 pencil
- 8. 1 paperclip
- 9. 100s chart

Directions

- 1. Pick something that your whole family would like to save for. Decide how much that thing might cost.
- 2. Draw a picture of it in the piggy bank.
- 3. Distribute 30 bingo chips to each player. Each bingo chip is equivalent to \$1.00.
- 4. Place 30 bingo chips in the piggy bank.
- 5. Shuffle the number cards and put them face down in the middle of the table.
- 6. The youngest player will go first. Write \$30 in the first piggy bank on the Piggy Bank Recording sheet to show the current amount of money in the family piggy bank.
- 7. The first player should then pick a number card from the top of the deck. That number will determine the amount of money that the player spends or saves.
- 8. The player will spin the spinner. If it lands on SAVE then the player should put the number of bingo chips on their card into the piggy bank. If the spinner lands on SPEND then the player should take the number of bingo chips out of the piggy bank.
- 9. After each turn, the player should fill out the Piggy Bank Recording Sheet. The should write the number of dollars that they spent or saved and then write a number sentence showing what they did. (You can use your 100s chart to help you.)
- 10. The game ends when one player runs out of bingo chips. Count the number of bingo chips in the piggy bank.

Do you have enough to meet your savings goal?
